



GANNOCHY AUDITORIUM



The Gannochy Auditorium is a modern and versatile space. Featuring state-of-the-art sound and lighting systems, it adapts to a range of layouts and events, from cabaret-style conferences and banquets to exhibitions and awards dinners.



NORIE-MILLER STUDIO



Conveniently located on the ground floor and fully accessible, the Norie-Miller Studio is an ideal space for meetings, drinks receptions, and exhibitions. Additionally, it serves as a breakout area when using the main auditorium.



TILT, EARN, ISLA, AND TAY ROOMS

FOYER



Our foyer is light and airy, with a contemporary glass frontage. Its flexible layout transforms easily to accommodate conference registrations, catering, exhibitions or private gatherings.



PERTH THEATRE – A CHERISHED HISTORIC VENUE

Perth Theatre reopened in 2017 following an extensive £16.6 million restoration and redevelopment. Designed by the award-winning Richard Murphy Architects, the building seamlessly surrounds the Victorian auditorium with modern facilities, including a flexible studio theatre, café, conservatory and community spaces.




FLOORPLAN

JOAN KNIGHT STUDIO

Our custom-built studio accommodates just over 200 seats, with 168 in a tiered seating bank. This flexible space can work in theatre format, or flat floor, seating up to 120 comfortably for cabaret-style events.



MAIN AUDITORIUM

Our meticulously restored Victorian auditorium features a raised stage and distinct seating areas. The ground floor is laid out in stalls, while the circle and the recently reopened upper circle (referred to as the 'gods') provide additional space.



THE SPACE



This fully accessible community space is perfect for meetings, workshops, or as a breakout room. It accommodates up to 80 guests in theatre-style seating and 50 in cabaret-style seating.

TECHNICAL SERVICES

We are well-suited to supporting your technical needs, with an expert in-house team to service all lighting, sound and AV requirements. Every space across both venues is equipped with free Wi-Fi, screen or projector systems, hearing facilities, tables and chairs. Additional amenities can be provided, such as lecterns, and the auditorium-style spaces have full PA systems. We can offer further specialist AV equipment at an additional cost. We can also support presentation production if needed.

LOCATION AND ACCOMMODATION

Perth is a historic city at the gateway to the Highlands. Dating back to prehistoric times, it is the former capital city of Scotland and is rich in history, culture, and local amenities. It has easy access to some of Scotland's most breathtaking scenery, with the Cairngorms National Park on the doorstep for hill walking, mountain climbing, skiing and camping.

HOW TO GET HERE

Transport Links: Perth is well-connected by various modes of transport:


Rail: Perth Railway Station offers regular services to major cities across Scotland, including Edinburgh, Glasgow and Inverness.

Bus: The city has an extensive bus network operated by Stagecoach East Scotland, providing local and regional services.

Road: Perth is easily accessible via the A9, A90, and M90 motorways, making it convenient for those travelling by car.

Air: Loganair operates direct flights from London Heathrow to Dundee, providing a convenient option for international and domestic travellers. Dundee Airport is just a short drive from Perth, making it an excellent choice for those flying in for events.

Car Parks: Multiple car parks are available, including the Kinnoull Street and Canal Street Multi-Story Car Parks nearest to the venues, and the South Inch Car Park, offering both short-term and long-term parking options.
